This does not include private loans that you are required to pay back.

- The due date for rising PN II students is April 30.
- All applications must be completed and submitted to the Practical Nursing Director by the due date to be considered for the scholarship.

Second-year students will qualify for the total tuition portion of the amount due. Students will continue to be responsible for associated fees. The due date for scholarship applications for second-year students is April 30 of the current school year. Awards funds will be applied directly to the student account, and the remaining fees must be paid by the 10th day of the fall semester.
